A small example would be access to public transportation, which impacts, ability to get and maintain work. When a permant job is not part of reentry, return to old ways is not far behind.

In my short time in the area I have been impressed with how community corrections works in Grand Traverse County. My experience in Wisconsin taught me the value of reentry for inmates. Reentry planning should be an essential part of incarceration while community corrections working with reentry must adapt their program to the local area. Wisconsin and Michigan are similar with their urban and rural differences.
