ITEM 1. Convening of the Meeting

Senator Posthumus called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m. and requested that Dianne Odrobina call the roll. A quorum was present.

Senator Posthumus asked for a motion to excuse absent members. Speaker Hertel moved, supported by Senator Steil, to excuse absent members. The motion was unanimously approved.

ITEM 2. Election of Officers

Senator Posthumus stated that a motion would be in order to nominate the Chair of the Legislative Council for 1998. **Senator Steil moved, supported by Representative Gagliardi, to elect Speaker Hertel as Chair.** The motion was unanimously approved.

Speaker Hertel stated that a motion would be in order to nominate the Alternate Chair of the Legislative Council for 1998. **Representative Gagliardi moved, supported by Representative Perricone, to elect Senator Posthumus as Alternate Chair.** The motion was unanimously approved.

ITEM 3. Appointments to Subcommittees of the Legislative Council

The Chair asked for a motion to approve the recommended list of subcommittee appointments. There was discussion, and a copy of the list was distributed to all members. ITEM 4. Approval of Minutes of October 30, 1997, Legislative Council Meeting

Speaker Hertel asked for a motion to adopt the minutes of the October 30, 1997, Legislative Council meeting. Representative Hanley moved, supported by Senator Steil, to adopt the minutes of the October 30, 1997 meeting. There was no discussion. The minutes were unanimously adopted.

ITEM 5. Proposed Schedule of Legislative Council Meetings Pursuant to Open Meetings Act

May 7, 1998, and September 24, 1998, were set as dates for Legislative Council meetings subject to the availability of the Chair and Alternate Chair as well as a quorum of Council members to attend on those dates.

National Conference of Insurance Legislators (NCOIL) Dues

Senator Bouchard spoke on behalf of the National Conference of Insurance Legislators (NCOIL) and gave a short summary of this group's recent activities. Much discussion followed regarding the issue of increased dues for both FY '97-'98 and FY'98-'99. Senator Posthumus moved, supported by Senator Steil, that the Legislative Council pay dues for FY '97-'98 equal to last year's dues (\$2,000) plus 3% and have the Services and Administration subcommittee determine if any increase above that amount should or should not be paid in the future.

Senator Posthumus stated that some legislators have requested that additional copies of the booklet "A Sesquicentennial Look At The Michigan Legislature: 150 Years of Lansing as the State Capital" be reprinted on a limited basis for distribution to schools, etc. Senator Posthumus moved, supported by Representative Gustafson, that the Legislative Service Bureau complete a one-time printing of this booklet for which requests from Legislators must be submitted by April 1, 1998. Much discussion followed regarding the number of publications currently available to Legislators.

Representative Hanley moved, supported by Senator Schwarz, to amend the motion on the floor to state that the April 1, 1998, deadline be eliminated and that the booklets be made

available for the remainder of the 1998 calendar year.
