The Nursing Home Administrators General Rules pertain to the licensure, relicensure, and renewal for nursing home administrators. The proposed rules will reorganize, update, and revise the current rules to comply with current statutory requirements and for clarity.

The proposed rules will add a Part 2 for education to update and clarify current requirements. The proposed rules will update information regarding accreditation standards and the approved course of instruction and training for licensure.

The proposed rules add a Part 3 for licensure. The proposed rules will relocate some rules for clarity, add rules to inform an applicant of current licensure requirements, and amend the examination requirements. The proposed rules will update the requirements for relicensure after lapse and for licensure by endorsement.

The proposed rules will add a new Part 4 and will reorganize the continuing education requirements into this section. The proposed rules will rescind some rules for organization and clarity and will rescind some rules because they do not comply with statutory requirements. The proposed rules will add new board approved continuing education course requirements. The proposed rules will reorganize and update other continuing education requirements.
