4. Describe the general purpose of these rules, including any problem(s) the changes are intended to address:

The rules were enacted to implement the program, but no funds were appropriated to the program and, therefore, it never became functional. The DNR was required by statute to promulgate the rules, but, PA 570 of 2018 amended Part 7 of NREPA, which created the program, and repealed the section of statute requiring the DNR to promulgate rules. Therefore, the DNR now proposes to rescind this ruleset, consistent with the recommendations by the Advisory Rules Committee.

5. Cite the specific rule promulgation authority (i.e. agency director, commission, board, etc., listing all applicable statutory references. If the rule(s) are mandated by any applicable constitutional or statutory provision, please explain.

The DNR was required by MCL 324.704(1) to promulgate the rules. However, PA 570 of 2018 repealed this section of statute, and, therefore, the DNR may now rescind this obsolete ruleset.

6. Describe the extent to which the rule(s) conflict with, duplicate, or exceed similar regulations, compliance requirements, or other standards adopted at the state, regional, or federal level. Include applicable public act and statutory references.

The ruleset does not conflict with any known regulations.

- **8.** Explain whether the rule(s) will be promulgated under Sections 44 or 48 of the APA or the full rulemaking process:

The ruleset is obsolete and will therefore be promulgated under MCL 24.244.

9. Do the rule(s) incorporate the recommendations of any Advisory Rules Committee formed pursuant to Executive Order 2011-5? If yes, explain.

Yes. The Advisory Rules Committee established that this ruleset is obsolete due to the lack of funding for the program created by Part 7 of NREPA and recommended rescission of the ruleset. However, the Advisory Rules Committee also recognized that the statute required the DNR to promulgate the ruleset, and the DNR could not rescind the ruleset until the Legislature amended Part 7 of NREPA. Since PA 570 of 2018 accomplished the necessary amendments to Part 7 of NREPA, the DNR now proposes to rescind the ruleset, consistent with the recommendation of the Advisory Rules Committee.
