These rules: a) set forth standards for evaluating rates charged in relation to policies issued under the Chapter 21 of the Insurance Code, MCL 500.2101 *et seq*. (also known as the Essential Insurance Act); b) establish procedures to be followed in processing requests for a "review and determination" under Section 2113 of the Insurance Code, MCL 500.2113; and c) set forth reporting and claim information requirements and procedures applicable to insurers. The proposed amendments will: a) clarify the processes applicable to review and determinations; b) make technical changes to more clearly differentiate between the "private informal managerial level conference" that must precede a review and determination, and the review and determination itself; and 3) provide for a remedy to be imposed by the Director to resolve review and determination based on an incorrect premium charge.
