4. Describe the general purpose of these rules, including any problem(s) the changes are intended to address:

These rules address the licensing requirements for foster family and group homes in the state. They provide the minimal standards for qualifications and investigation of prospective and current foster care parents. The rules also address the family or group home standards, including fire safety. The rules were last updated in 2015. Since that time, federal law requirements have changed to require model foster home standards and new issues have evolved that require a review of the entire rule set to address such current issues involving LGBT youth, vaccinations, and variance requirements. Further, there are conflicts within the child caring institution, child placing agencies, and foster family and group home rules that need to be amended for consistency for the contracted agencies providing services.
