The Government Provider DSH Pool is a pool for non-state government-owned or -operated hospitals. The purpose of the pool is to ensure funding for costs incurred by public facilities providing inpatient hospital services which serve a disproportionate number of low-income patients with special needs. Effective for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 payment calculation, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) will increase the Government Provider DSH Pool from \$82,086,703 to \$94,649,000. The pool will remain at this amount for subsequent fiscal years. Distributions to hospitals from the pool will be consistent with current distribution methodology.
