The purpose of this bulletin is to inform Medicaid Fee-for-Service (FFS) NEMT authorizing parties of changes to FFS NEMT policy. Refer to the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) Medicaid Provider Manual for policy information regarding Medicaid FFS transportation policy. For services for Medicaid beneficiaries enrolled in a Medicaid Health Plan (MHP), Integrated Care Organization (ICO) or MI Choice Waiver agency, the beneficiary's health plan or waiver agency should be contacted for policy and coverage information. Mileage Reimbursement

Medicaid may authorize mileage reimbursement for NEMT rendered to beneficiaries for services eligible for Medicaid coverage when policy criteria are met. Providers who may be eligible to receive reimbursement include volunteer drivers, foster care parents, individuals with a vested interest (e.g., family, legal guardian, friends, etc.), commercial and nonprofit providers, public transportation providers, and Medicaid beneficiaries who provide their own NEMT.

Effective December 1, 2019, the NEMT mileage reimbursement rate will align with the State of Michigan Standardized Travel Regulations issued by the Michigan Civil Service Commission and Michigan Department of Technology, Management and Budget. The MDHHS NEMT Rate Schedule will be updated according to changes made to the Standardized Travel Regulations.
