The Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs will hold a public hearing to receive public comments on proposed changes to the Subdivisions of Land rule set.

The amendments of the Subdivision of Lands rule set are proposed to take effect 7 days after filing with the Secretary of State. The proposed rule set (2020-12 LR) is for the approval of plats, including forms, certificates of approval, and other required certificates, captioning of plats and numbering of lots. The proposed changes address removing sections that overreach the authority of the state, clarifying the approval path for a specific platting situation, and updating language and procedure to accept new technologies. These rules are required for the implementation and operation of a program unique to Michigan and established by state law in 1967, the Land Division Act, 1967 PA 288, MCL 560.101 to MCL 560.293. No federal standards or rules exist for the administration of this program.

The Subdivisions of Land rules are mandated by authority conferred on the departments labor and economic growth, transportation, and environmental quality by section 105 of 1967 PA 288, MCL 560.105, and Executive Reorganization Order Nos. 1973-2, 1980-1, 1996-2, and 2003-1 being MCL 299.11, 16.732, 445.2001, and 445.2011. Each part of the rules is promulgated separately by the department whose name appears in the designation of that part. These rules will take effect 7 Days after filing with the Secretary of State. The rules are published on the Michigan Government web site at http://www.michigan.gov/moahr and in the Michigan Register in the 10/1/2020 issue.
