Rule Set 2020-116 LR Physician's Assistants – General Rules

Rules Primer

The rule set pertains to the licensure, relicensure, and license renewals of physician's assistants. The rules will be amended to incorporate legislative changes and update educational and licensure requirements.

Summary of the Final Proposed Rule

The proposed rules do all the following:

- Adopt updated educational standards.
- Incorporate recent legislative changes that allow licensure by endorsement for individuals licensed in another state or a province of Canada.
- Revise the requirements for verification of licenses held in other jurisdictions.

Stakeholder Engagement

Development of the proposed rules occurred in consultation with members of the Task Force on Physician's Assistants via rules committee work groups, which included the opportunity for the public and associations to attend and supply input. The web address
