This bulletin is issued in response to the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 budget appropriations of Public Act 166 of 2020. From state-appropriated funds, Section 1790 of the Act directs MDHHS to increase Medicaid practitioner reimbursement rates for pediatric psychiatric services paid through Medicaid Fee-for-Service and through the Medicaid Health Plans for beneficiaries under the age of 21 years.

Effective for dates of service on and after January 1, 2021, practitioner reimbursement rates for program covered pediatric psychiatric services within Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) code range 90832 through 90889 will be reimbursed at 63% of the Medicare annual rate for specified services. All Medicaid practitioner rates are reviewed and updated annually and published at <a href="https://www.michigan.gov/medicaidproviders">www.michigan.gov/medicaidproviders</a> >> Billing & Reimbursement >> Provider Specific Information >> Physicians/Practitioners/Medical Clinics.
