The purpose of this policy is to revise language in the BEM to update the definition of a vehicle. This change is being made to align language in the BEM to updated terminology in the Programs Operational Manual System (POMS). This is necessary as the POMS acts as a template for SSI-related Medicaid policies in Michigan as Michigan follows Section 1634 of the Social Security Act.

The definition of a(n) automobile/vehicle has been updated in the POMS. To maintain the intent of the automobile/vehicle policy for SSI-related Medicaid programs in Michigan, the definition of vehicle is being updated in BEM item 400. The updated definition is "any registered or unregistered vehicle used for transportation. Vehicles used for transportation include, but are not limited to, cars, trucks, motorcycles, boats, snowmobiles, animal-drawn vehicles, and even animals. It does not include pull-behind trailers or fifth wheels."

The current definition in BEM 400 is "a device used to transport people or goods. Vehicle includes passenger cars, trucks, motorcycles, motorbikes, trailers, campers, motor homes, boats and all-terrain vehicles." The update will remove trailers and campers as excludable vehicles and changed to include animal-drawn vehicles/animals that pull the vehicles.

The policy language for burial space item exclusions is also being updated. The clarifying language is intended to ensure the policy clearly indicates an applicant can hold one each of a burial space item (each of which serves a different purpose) for any of the individuals listed in policy under SSI-Related MA Burial Space Exclusion in BEM 400 as applicable.
