The Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs will hold a public hearing to receive public comments on proposed changes to the Public Health Code - Disciplinary Rules rule set.

The proposed revisions to the rules clarify the disciplinary action that the department may take based on conduct occurring before licensure, registration, relicensure, or reregistration; clarify the licensee's or registrant's continuing duty to report criminal convictions; clarify the licensee's or registrant's duties when applying for relicensure or reregistration; clarify the department's review process when determining if reasonable grounds for an investigation exist; clarify when an administrative complaint may be amended; add a rule concerning cease and desist orders; and, clarify the situations when a disciplinary subcommittee may rely on prior final orders when determining whether grounds for discipline exist.

By authority conferred on the director of the department of licensing and regulatory affairs by section 33 (3) of the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.233, section 16141 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.16141, and Executive Reorganization Order Nos. 1991-9, 1996-2, 2003-1, and 2011-4, MCL 338.3501, 445.2001, 445.2011, and 445.2030. The proposed rules will take effect immediately after filing with the Secretary of State.
