BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2020-042 LR would make amendments, rescissions, and an addition to rules regarding the practice of osteopathic medicine, which is regulated in Michigan by the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA). Specific changes accomplished by the rule set would include the following: revision of definitions; inclusion of a rule regarding telehealth services; revision of rules regarding prescribing of drugs by physician's assistants and delegation of controlled substance prescribing to advanced practice registered nurses; revision of rules regarding accreditation standards, licensure, relicensure, examinations, and continuing education; and rescission of several rules, including a rule on examination eligibility.

2020-042 LR is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on LARA or any other unit of state or local government.
