BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2021-55 LR would make numerous amendments and an addition to rules pertaining to the audiology profession. The rule set would make typographical revisions; incorporate legislative changes allowing for licensure by endorsement for individuals licensed in another state or Canadian province; revise license verification requirements for licenses held in other jurisdictions; update audiology education program and continuing education accreditation standards; revise relicensure pathways; and include a new rule regarding scope of practice, consent, and standard of care for telehealth services.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2021-55 LR is not anticipated to have a significant fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or on any other unit of state or local government.
