Rule Set 2021-71 LR would make numerous amendments to rules pertaining to the massage therapy profession. Specifically, the rule set would update the rule regarding training for identifying human trafficking victims, add references for licensure requirements contained in other rule sets, reorganize the rule regarding licensure by endorsement, and make other amendments to licensure rules.
