This policy clarifies the requirements for entering hardcopy Level of Care Determination (LOCD) into the Community Health Automated Medicaid Processing System (CHAMPS) following a change of ownership (CHOW) for a nursing facility.

A nursing facility provider that is in the process of a CHOW and obtaining a national provider identifier (NPI) must conduct the hardcopy version of the LOCD and Freedom of Choice form. Once the provider is given access to CHAMPS under their new NPI, the provider must enter all the information from the hard copy LOCD into the online version of the LOCD in CHAMPS under the new NPI. The hardcopy LOCDs must be entered in CHAMPS within 30 days of the approval date of the new NPI with Provider Enrollment. The records meeting this requirement will have the start date modified to equal the record's conducted date.
