BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2021-95 LR would make numerous amendments to rules pertaining to the practice of podiatric medicine. Specifically, the rule set would accomplish the following changes:

- Clarify training standards for identifying victims of human trafficking.
- Clarify requirements for licensure by examination.
- Amend and clarify examination requirements for licensure.
- Amend and clarify requirements for licensure by endorsement.
- Clarify requirements related to the educational limited license.
- Clarify requirements for relicensure.
- Update educational program standards adopted by reference.
- Amend license renewal and continuing education requirements.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2021-95 LR would not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or any other state or local government units.
