The Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), will hold a public hearing on **Thursday, January 6, 2022, from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.** in Constitution Hall, Ford Conference Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, South Tower, 525 West Allegan Street, Lansing, Michigan 48933. Members of the public may also attend the hearing online (see below for details). The hearing will be held to receive public comments on proposed changes to Part 8: Emission Limitations and Prohibitions – Oxides of Nitrogen, promulgated pursuant to Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

The Part 8 Rules were developed to address federal regulations referred to as the "NOx SIP Call" and the Clean Air Interstate Rule (CAIR), and to create an emissions trading program to reduce overall nitrogen oxides (NOx) concentrations for incorporation into Michigan's State Implementation Plan (SIP). In 2015, implementation of the Cross State Air Pollution Rule, another federal regulation, replaced the federal CAIR. As such, CAIR references need to be removed from several Part 8 Rules. The trading program in our Part 8 Rules is no longer applicable and must be removed. Additionally, the NOx SIP Call requirements for a small subset of sources must be updated.

If approved, the rules will be submitted to the USEPA as an amendment to the Michigan State Implementation Plan (SIP). The comment period and hearing will fulfill requirements contained in the state administrative rules and the federal Clean Air Act.

These rules are promulgated by authority conferred on the Director of EGLE by Section 5512 of Act 451, MCL 324.5512. These rules will take immediate effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.

The rules are published on the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules' Web site at <https://ars.apps.lara.state.mi.us/Transaction/RFRTransaction?TransactionID=1282>. The rules will also be published in the December 15, 2021, issue of the *Michigan Register*.


