**Podiatric Medicine and Surgery  
General Rules (MOAHR #2021-95 LR)**

Authority: MCL 333.16145, MCL 333.16148, MCL 333.16174, MCL 333.16178, MCL 333.16182, MCL 333.16186, MCL 333.16204, MCL 333.16205, MCL 333.16287, MCL 333.18031, and MCL 333.18033, and Executive Reorganization Order Nos. 1991-9, 1996-2, 2003-1, and 2011-4, MCL 338.3501, MCL 445.2001, MCL 445.2011, and MCL 445.2030.

Overview: The proposed rules will amend and clarify the training standards for identifying victims of human trafficking, the requirements for licensure by examination, and the requirements for licensure by endorsement. The proposed rules will also amend the examination requirements for licensure to reflect the current testing requirements for each license type. The requirements for licensure by endorsement and relicensure will be amended to require the applicant to disclose each health care credential ever held and to have resolved any disciplinary action taken against that health care credential before being licensed by endorsement or relicensed. The proposed rules will also update the standards for educational programs and amend and clarify the training and continuing education requirements for license renewal and the approved activities and sponsors for accumulating continuing education credits.

The rules will take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State, unless specified otherwise in the rules. Comments on the proposed rules may be presented in person at the public hearing. Written comments will also be accepted from date of publication until **5:00 p.m. on August 16, 2022**, at the following address or e-mail address:


