## BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2020-96 LR would replace the Electric Interconnection and Net Metering Standards rule set, which would be rescinded by rule set 2020-95 LR. The rule sets pertain to how projects owned by customers, developers, and utilities connect to the utility distribution system. The changes contained in 2020-95 LR and 2020-96 LR are being pursued to implement necessary updates, due to rapid advances in distributed energy resource technology and increased distributed generation.

## FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2020-96 LR would not be anticipated to have a significant fiscal impact on the Public Service Commission (MPSC). The MPSC anticipates that reduced workload resulting from the rules would lead to indeterminate cost savings, even if an increased volume of interconnections occurs. The rule set would not be anticipated to have fiscal impact on any other units of state or local government.

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
