The proposed revisions include updates to environmental health baccalaureate program accreditation standards and environmental health graduate program accreditation standards, grammatical edits to comply with current drafting standards, expansion of the period in which an applicant may pass the examination for reregistration, and removal of the reference to the two-year registration cycle.
