4. Describe the general purpose of these rules, including any problem(s) the changes are intended to address:

These rules address the licensing requirements for child placing agencies in the state. They provide the minimal standards of foster care, adoption, and independent living standards including staff qualifications, licensing of foster family and group homes, recruitment of foster parents, training of foster parents, and placement of children for adoption. The rules were last updated in 2015. Since that time, federal law requirements have changed which include model standards for foster family homes, and new issues have evolved that require a review of the entire rule set to address such current issues involving LGBT youth, vaccinations, and variance requirements. Further, there are conflicts within the child caring institution, child placing agencies, and foster family and group home rules that need to be amended for consistency for the contracted agencies providing services.
