### **BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES**

Rule Set 2017-084 LR would make several amendments to existing rules pertaining to tunnel excavation. The rule set would add a definition for “auger boring and jacking” and add clarifying language to other existing rules.

### **FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES**

2017-084 LR would have a minor fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA), resulting in estimated departmental costs of \$2,200. LARA estimates that expenditures for printing and distribution of the rules would total \$200, while necessary training for Michigan Occupational Safety and Health Administration staff is estimated at \$2,000. Considering the limited magnitude of the requisite expenditures and the agency’s existing budget for training, existing appropriations will likely be sufficient to completely support any departmental expense. There would not be a fiscal impact on any other unit of state or local government.
