BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2018-040 LR would make numerous amendments, additions, and rescissions to rules pertaining to licensure and relicensure of nursing home administrators. The rule set would also reorganize the rules for added clarity. Specific changes that would be accomplished by the rule set include: updating accreditation standards, updating the approved course of instruction and training, updating examination requirements, a new rule stipulating a date for compliance with identification of human trafficking requirements, a new rule requiring foreign-trained applicants to obtain a certain TOEFL score, and numerous changes to rules regarding licensure and continuing education.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2018-040 LR is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or any other unit of state or local government.
