BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2018-107 LR would make numerous amendments and an addition and rescission to the rules pertaining to the practice of psychology. Specific changes accomplished through the rule set include: clarifying definitions; establishing deadlines for when human trafficking victim identification training must be completed; updating accreditation, licensure, and relicensure standards; updating examination and continuing education requirements; rescinding a rule on prohibited conduct that is duplicative of statute; and making typographical revisions.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2018-107 LR is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or any other unit of state or local government.

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
