BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2019-84 LR would make numerous amendments to rules pertaining to chiropractic practitioners. The rule set would clarify definitions, adopt by reference accreditation standards for chiropractic education programs, revise continuing education requirements to stipulate that acceptable continuing education must be approved or offered by the Michigan Association of Chiropractors (with limited exceptions), and make other typographical revisions and corrections.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2019-84 LR is not anticipated to have a significant fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or on any other state or local government units.

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
