BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2021-95 LR would make numerous amendments to rules pertaining to the practice of podiatric medicine. Specifically, the rule set would clarify training standards for identifying victims of human trafficking, clarify requirements for licensure by examination, amend and clarify examination requirements for licensure, amend and clarify requirements for licensure by endorsement, clarify requirements related to the educational limited license, clarify requirements for relicensure, update educational program standards adopted by reference, and amend license renewal and continuing education requirements.
