NOTICE OF MINING PERMIT AMENDMENT
Humboldt Mill MP 01 2010
Humboldt Township, Marquette County

The Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Oil, Gas, and Minerals Division (OGMD), received a request from Eagle Mine LLC (Eagle) on May 7, 2024, to amend Mining Permit MP 01 2010, issued under Part 632, Nonferrous Metallic Mineral Mining, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Part 632). Eagle proposes adding a pyrrhotite recovery circuit that will produce a new concentrate within the existing mill, constructing a tailings dewatering and load-out facility in preparation for future use of dewatered tailings as paste backfill at Eagle Mine, and rerouting the main access road.

The proposed operations and new construction will be within the permitted mining area boundary, and changes to the mining plan are not expected to result in increased environmental impacts as previously evaluated in the Environmental Impact Assessment of the mining permit application and addressed in the approved mining permit conditions. Therefore, EGLE has determined that the amendment request does not constitute a significant change from the conditions of the approved mining permit and shall issue approval within 14 days of the date of this publication of notice.




