## **BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES**

Rule Set 2018-106 LR would make numerous amendments and rescissions, and an addition, to rules pertaining to licensure and relicensure of podiatrists. Specific changes that would be accomplished by the rule set include: updating of the rule set's definitions, inclusion of a deadline for completion of human trafficking victim identification training, inclusion of new rule requiring demonstrated proficiency of English (as demonstrated via a specific TOEFL score) if an applicant's education or training was completed outside the United States, updating licensure by examination requirements, updating licensure by endorsement language, updating educational limited licensing language, revising continuing education requirements, clarifying the rule regarding educational and residency requirements, and rescinding a duplicative rule on patient records.

## **FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES**

2018-106 LR is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or any other unit of state or local government.

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
