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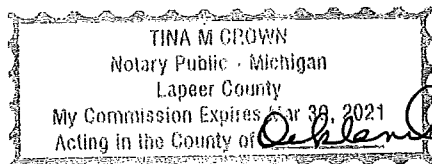

The proposed rules will amend several areas of the Blood Lead Analysis Reporting rules. In addition to minor grammatical and formatting corrections and amending definitions, the changes proposed include receipt of laboratory results of lead samples with decimal points, rather than rounding to integers, and to specify how laboratories should report results less than the limit of detection.

By authority conferred on the Department of Health and Human Services by 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.5111(1) and (2)(f); 333.5474(1)(c), and 333.2053, These rules will take effect 30 days after filing with the Secretary of State. 
