R 408.65 of the Michigan Administrative Code is amended, as follows:

R 408.65 Adoption of standards by reference.

Rule 5. A person shall construct, install, and operate a ski lift as prescribed in ANSI standards B77.1-2017 entitled "American National Standard for Passenger Ropeways – Aerial Tramways, Aerial Lifts, Surface Lifts, Tows and Conveyors - Safety Standard," which is adopted by reference in these rules. This standard may be purchased as an electronic download from the American National Standards Institute, Inc. at https://www.ansi.org for \$200.00. The standard is available for inspection and purchase for \$200.00 at the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, of Construction Codes, at 611 W.
