RE: JCAR No. 22-22 (MOAHR 2020-11) – Department of Treasury, Michigan Gaming Control Board, Fantasy Contests Rules


Dear Ms. Rowley:

As Chair and Alternate Chair of the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, it has come to our attention that the Michigan Department of Treasury is asking for permission to withdraw the proposed rules identified as "Fantasy Contests Rules" (JCAR No. 22-22; MOAHR 2020-11) as described in your letter dated May 24, 2022.

Per MCL 24.245a(10) a rule is withdrawn with permission if the withdrawal is approved by the Chair and Alternate Chair. This section further provides that if permission to withdraw is granted, the 15-session-day period for committee review is tolled until the rule is resubmitted, subject to the requirement that the committee must have at least 6 session days after resubmission to consider the resubmitted rule.

On behalf of the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules and pursuant to the authority of the Chair and Alternate Chair under MCL 24.245a(10), we grant permission to the Michigan Department of Treasury to withdraw the proposed rules.
