BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2021-57 LR would make numerous amendments to rules pertaining to the licensure of veterinarians. Specific changes accomplished by the rule set would include the following:

- Clarifying and revising requirements for telehealth service provision (to ensure veterinary care standards are met).
- Updating examination and accreditation standards.
- Amending licensure and relicensure requirements.
- Clarifying delegation and supervision requirements.
- Revising a rule regarding animal patient medical records to ensure the retention of relevant information.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES
