BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2021-3 LR would make numerous amendments and additions to rules pertaining to consumer standards and billing practices for electric and natural gas service. Specifically, the rule set would incorporate provisions from the Technical Standards for Electric Service and the Service Quality and Reliability Standards for Electric Distribution Systems rule sets that would be more appropriate within the billing rules.

2021-3 LR would not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or on any other unit of state or local government.
