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| 23-32 | Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy- Air Quality Division- Air Pollution Control | Part 6. Emission Limitations and Prohibitions- Existing Sources of Volatile Organic Compound Emissions |

FISCAL IMPACT: The proposed rule set would result in a minor fiscal impact for the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) and have no fiscal impact on local units of government. The proposed rule set would amend the current rules under the federal Clean Air Act (CAA) used to address moderate nonattainment area provisions for National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). Specifically, the proposed rule set would amend the requirements regarding the process by which EGLE historically has promulgated the current rules under the CAA. The department would potentially experience an increase in costs due to the increased workload for Air Quality Division (AQD) staff. AQD staff would potentially receive an increase in requests for permit revisions from certain areas, and additional monitoring by the department may be required. The proposed rule set is not likely to affect revenues or costs for local units of government.
